Eric Ramlo requested information on the location of old minutes. The board will locate these, and update at the next meeting.

Ron and Sue Cavanaugh requested reimbursement for payment of fallen tree on neighbor's property. Bucky informed them that the law states that anything that falls into the road is the responsibility of the township, and even though the tree is in the easement, it is not owned by the township.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 pm


